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# 2023 Bordeaux: An Introduction

Our team of seven spent the week of April 22nd visiting and tasting the top Chateaux during the En Primeur Week. We tasted most wines several times in order to give us a broad and knowledgeable insight into the vintage and its wines.

This was my 38th Campaign and it seems like no vintage is ever the same and it is difficult to make comparisons.

2023 Red Bordeaux is a good to very good vintage with a few outstanding wines. The wines have a lower alcohol level than recent previous vintages which is very welcome indeed. The reds are very approachable and can be enjoyed young but will certainly age gracefully. The wines have great freshness and balance with good acidity with the top wines displaying that rich mid palate sweet ripe fruit.

Normally when assessing a new vintage there usually is a particular commune that stands out and critics will comment as such, but for our team we found the quality was even throughout.

The dry whites are one of the best vintages I have tasted. Displaying all the characteristics of a great white Bordeaux. There is plenty to choose from at all price levels.

Finally, this is an extremely good vintage for Sauternes showing great balance and power with the requisite amount of botrytis. This is certainly a vintage to take note of, especially as the prices should be quite reasonable.

Having spoken with many owners and Negociants the pricing of 2023 will most certainly be lower than 2022 and given the quality of the vintage there should be some bargains to be had.


